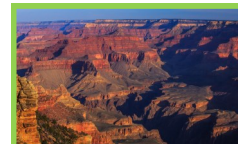


The Amazing Americas KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER

Identify the states of the USA and the state capitals. Identify the different time zones across the USA.

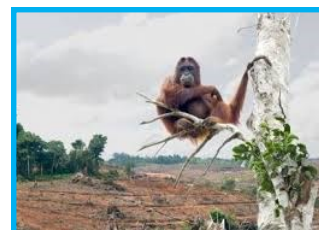

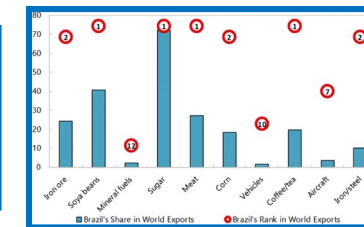
Palm oil products
